The Quality of Programme Checker is a tool designed to help you to plan and review your programmes, and make sure that you are delivering quality Scouting to the young people that you work with. A quality Scouting programme should cover all of the areas identified by the tool. The red, amber and green categories will help you to identify any areas where your programme could be improved, and set targets for you to reach when planning your next programme. The figures included in the red, amber and green categories have been calculated following research with Section Leaders.

This tool could be used to review programmes which you have already run and identify areas that need a greater focus for the coming term or year, or new programmes which you are planning for the term or year ahead to make sure there aren't any gaps. You should tick the box next to the answer that best applies to your programme for each question.

To make sure that the tool is as beneficial as possible, you should be open and honest when completing it. You could share your results with others in your District, and discuss best practice and tips for improving the quality of your own and others programmes.
